NYC / =1st:

Receiver: Marantz AV7005 does NOT support 4K =assthrough
Projector: Epson LS10000 is 4K HDR =ompatible
Cables: uncertain, assuming not 4K

Zorro:

Receiver: Mcintosh MX121AV does =OT support 4K passthrough
Projector: =pson LS10000 is 4K HDR compatible
Cables: uncertain, assuming =K

LSJ:

Receiver: Mcintosh MX121AV does NOT support 4K =assthrough
Projector: Espon Pro =1505UNL — upscales to 4K, not actual 4K
Cables: uncertain, assuming not 4K

Palm Beach:

Receiver: Marantz SR7009 is 4K =ompatible
TV: Samsung UN75HU8550F is 4K =ompatible, may not support HDR
Cables: =ncertain, assuming 4K

Paris... =BD.

I'd =uggest sending an Apple TV 4K down to Palm Beach to replace their =existing Apple TV and seeing if it works as =xpected.

If it does, consider the Marantz SR7009
