That night, I went on Googl= and found out, for the first time, about his career, which began as a mem=er of first hired group of physicists at NASA in 1958 (to work on Project =ercury alongside Alan Shepard and John Glenn) and his work as one of the l=egendary "MAD scientists of MPD" in using plasma physics to=provide the rocket thrust to achieve reliable orbit; and culminated as the=technical head of the amazingly successful NASA/FAA effort to improve pass=nger aircraft safety. Who knew? We never had a conversation about it and w= did stay in touch over the years. See the piece I wrote and the obit in t=e local NASA paper below.
