DRR accounts for just 0.4% of the total amount =pent on international aid. Essentially, for every \$100 spent on develop=ent aid, just 40 cents have been invested in defending from the i=act of disasters. I believe that we have to change those numbers. We have=to move from the tradition of response, to a culture of preventio=.
