Dear Mark and Michael:

It has been over 4 months since the University put me on paid leave, limited my ability to be on campus and interact with colleagues and staff, and abruptly cancelled the 10th anniversary Origins events without consulting me or my staff about the contingency plans we had in the event of BuzzFeed publishing a story. Since that time

the lives of myself and many ASU staff have been disrupted, and our work has been obstructed. The new term will begin in a month and it is already getting late to organize events for the fall.

I was last interviewed by Erin Ellison on May 4th, at which time she informed me that this interview completed her investigation and that her office would be forwarding her report on to the General Counsel within two weeks, and furthermore that she expected it would be forwarded to the provost by the third week of May. It is now the third week of July, and the only contact I have received from Ms. Ellison since that time was an oddly inappropriate email query on June 21.

This continuing situation creates an environment for me and my staff in which it is difficult or impossible to continue our academic pursuits, meet our employment goals, and participate in university-sponsored programs or activities. The longer this situation persists, the more onerous it becomes, and I am thus writing to find out when the University will act regarding my situation and the holding pattern for Origins.
