Thank you for your comment. You say we are not at an end, but scientifically we are only at an exciting beginning. We did follow up the San Diego data and planned a good international study with the necessary control to show an effect. Because you were unwilling to fund this and wanted the effect to be demonstrated before the study, we decided to do an off-the-cuff study and there was a definite effect. However, a proper scientific study would be the only way in which we could demonstrate this categorically. With the funds available (plus a further £10k) we have enough data to carry out a proper controlled trial, and shall go ahead with this as far as we can. Could you confirm whether you feel able to give us any further help with the project? It's difficult to talk here if you want to discuss this, but I'll be back in London on the 7th September. Thank you for all the help you have already given which has enabled us to get this far.
