thanks for your note, which Justin has passed along to me. I have no intent to disparage the University. I released a short factual statement about my choice to retire to the press and the review process that is now completed, without commentary. My statement about the atmosphere at the University not being conducive to me if I were to return has nothing to do with the University but rather to me. It has to do with the publicity surrounding my current situation and my concerns for my own protection should I put myself in an environment where future false claims might be likely to be lodged against me. Also, I did not release my retirement letter to the press as you claimed, and have no intention of releasing it. That letter was meant for President Crow and its purpose was to communicate facts to him as I experienced them associated with my decision to retire that President Crow can explore to help the University and protect the University Community in the future.
