Sylvester indicated the hard wood ordered after the hurricanes was for the replacement Storm Shutters in the main compound, no hardwood was ordered for the dock I contacted Jimmy His Crew routed edges, but did not cut to length, 1 bundle of Pressure treated wood, which was left exposed on top of the Desal Building The wood on the dock matches what was existing, except for 4 pieces, which will be replaced please note we sorted thru 3 stacks trying to find reasonable wood to lay

As discussed at Friday's meeting =A0last week, the dock will have a heavy foot and buggy traffic on it for the next 2-3 months<=span> Recommend </=iv> Sand Stain and marine varnish finish the dock to protect wood =A0 Research alternative decking, that will be more durable to heavy traffic<=div> Can we proceed with finishing the dock ?
