When the vessel =eft the army it went to the State if North Carolina DOT as 'West =ay'. They used it to replenish oyster beds in their tidewater =reas. (See photos)

It was sold north to people unknown at this time. =andy King has it now and wants to sell it.

Only two credible vessels like it are for sale... this one is the newest and by far, the most accessible. The ad for the sale has been taken down but they had it listed for \$700k plus and reduced it to \$500k plus.
