My apologies for the delay in responding to your email. Please be assured that I will work as quickly as I can to investigate the claims that you made during our meeting on Tuesday. I believe that Pedro forwarded the pictures, as we discussed.

Please be advised that it has been brought to our attention that there is still activity happening on Great St. James. On January 30, 2019, we received a report from Enforcement stating that they saw machinery moving stuff around on the shore on the Christmas Cove side of the island. Enforcement also spotted what looked to be a barge delivering a dump truck to the island. As we discussed in our meeting, the C&D is still in place until we have resolved the questions of the permits, and repair work is required to be reported to the Department. One purpose of these policies is to ensure that any work is being done in a way that would have minimal adverse effects on the environment. As Pedro mentioned in our meeting= no Best Management Practices were put in place for any of the activities done on the island. ♦=A0 The exclusion of BMP's can result in additional citations= Please note that marine impact may constitute a federal offense if any protected Endangered Species Act species are observed in the impacted area. Amy Dempsey could provide further information on this topic.<=>

We trust that you will notify your client of what we=discussed so that he can avoid any further issues with the department.♦=A0 I will notify you of what I find regarding the permit issue.<=u>
