IN THE MEAN TIME....

this vessel is the former LCU1672, US Army Bush Master. 135' shallow draft 180 ton landing craft.
Built 1976. Twin 12-71 Detroit Diesel naturally aspirated propulsion engines with 4 blades propellers=housed in Kort Nozzles. Two onboard generators. Keel cooled.

When the vessel left the army it went to the State of North Carolina DOT as 'West Bay'. They used it to replenish oyster beds in their tidewater areas. (See photos)

It was sold north to people unknown at this time. Randy King has it now and wants to sell it.

Only two credible vessels like it are for sale... this one is the newest and by far, the most accessible. The ad for the sale has been taken down but they had it listed for \$700k plus and reduced it to \$500k plus.

This isn't like buying a car. There are only so many of these and the newest of the bunch is in your back yard and not in the other side of the planet.

Not to go look at it is crazy as JE said he wants one. Told me so. Told me to choose. I have. Let's go look.
