When the vessel left the a=my it went to the State if North Carolina DOT as 'West Bay'. They used=it to replenish oyster beds in their tidewater areas. (See photos)

It was sold north to people unkn=wn at this time. Randy King has it now and wants to sell it.

Only two credible vessels =ike it are for sale... this one is the newest and by far, the most accessi=le. The ad for the sale has been taken down but they had it listed for \$70=k plus and reduced it to \$500k plus.

This isn't like buying a=car. There are only so many of these and the newest of the bunch is in you= back yard and not in the other side of the planet.

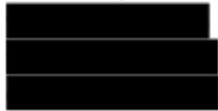

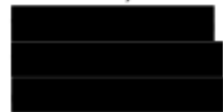
