For that reason, Ed Kammerer left as the date for commencement of the pre-buy inspection "April 12, or as soon thereafter as the inspection facility's schedule can accommodate." & nbs;As the "outside closing date" by which the Aircraft is to be completed and ready for delivery, Ed provided in the revised APA that the closing date would be "in no event later than June 28, 2019 (the "Closing Date") unless extended by the mutual written consent of Buyer and Seller which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld." I am ok with that.

- 1250 hour inspection – removed because it is 395 hours away
- = R&R all main rotor spindle outer race bearings =93 removed as this is done in the 1250 hour inspection
- = Main rotor spindle NDT =80 removed as this is done in the 1250 hour inspection

Oxygen bottles - apologies it's coming piece meal because I'm sending from my phone. My next email will show the date of the float bottles which do not come due in April. Helotrac is incorrect.
