The option with a cable from LSJ to GSJ as the primary feed is unreliable because it's one radial feed, meaning it comes from just one direction and one route. Any damage to the utility feeder, pad, switch, one cable and both LSJ and GSJ are out of power until repairs are completed. While this is currently the case you would have more exposure with two systems. This includes damage to the switch caused by a fault on either of your two islands.
