He changed the batteries and the blown fuse but the filters all have to be ordered. We will continue to have delays with the switchover when WAPA goes down until those filters are changed due to bad air flow.

I just spoke with Jock "the Diesel Man" in Subbase. I asked if he could come out to take a look at our Generators to see if he can do maintenance or setup a maintenance contract with us. I've been trying to get Jock to work with us for years but he's always been busy during our time of need. I finally got him to agree to come out Wednesday at 9am
