Dear Dr Fenwick,

I write further to your letter to the College's Professor Simon McVeigh, dated 13 February 2017. I apologise that this correspondence has taken some time to reach you and for the inconvenience and uncertainty that this may have caused.

The College's Ethical Committee to Consider the Acceptance of Gifts is scheduled to convene a meeting on 21 February 2017. On that occasion, the Committee will consider the offer made by the Enhanced Education Trust to contribute funding to work being done by yourself and Professor Joydeep Bhattacharya.

It is recognised that it would be preferable to be able to accept or decline the aforementioned offer at the earliest possible occasion. To that end, efforts have been made to convene the Committee's meeting on an earlier date. Unfortunately, however, these have not been successful. I deeply regret the frustration that will undoubtedly be caused by the delayed decision making process in this matter.
