They are held as USD in the bitcoin exchange Bitstamp in Luxembourg. I have not yet figured out how to transfer them to the US. My German bank does not accept transactions from Bitcoin exchanges, and Bitstamp does not do indirect wires (my US bank is a FCU that uses a proxy bank for having money wired in). I will probably have to open a different US bank account to get them here. (I could also transfer the money to a different cryptocurrency exchange and from there to Paypal, but I don't trust the banking practices of most exchanges very much.)
