Stanley Fire Dept have stationed a Fire Truck, Water Wagon and support personal at the Zorro Boundary fence line. Santa Fe County has also placed a Fire Truck at the Zorro Fuel Depot.

&nbs; Steve and Carlos have moved the Water Truck to fence line & Foam Trainer is filled ready to be moved to any location required

Winds are high running about 30 miles an hour, but are expected to drop during the evening hours

Amber & Cyntia are keeping in touch with everyone, we will update you with any changes or developments

Please note fire is not fully contained, but=not totally out of control, all Fire Personal are taking precautions around=the entire King Property Line and the entire Zorro crew are on site
