Rich -

I checked again with my assistant and she assures me that she has not had any conversation with you or message from you all week, so I am mystified by your assertion that you have left messages for me, but the information I am still looking for is noted below, in our exchange from Monday. It is (a) information about Noam's income (so I can understand what portion of his expenses can be met from sources other than the trusts), (b) what period the tax payments made from the trust in 2017 covered and what the \$300K covers, and (c) what additional [REDACTED] expenses have been (though I understand that the nature of those expenses is subject to confidentiality).

Harry's attorney would like to communicate with you and/or Noam's attorney to discuss how to move forward on my replacement, as well as about a more global settlement.

I will be out of pocket very shortly, and for the rest of the day, but I can reply to further emails tomorrow, or schedule a call.

Thank you for this =nformation Richard. I will need some time to consider it. =hile I'm doing so, could you please consider these initial =uestions:

1. The fees to Anthony Arnove seem extraordinarily high, as I understand his =ontract was terminated in June. Can you fill that in for =e?
2. There is no reference to "daily living" costs. Can you =allpark a monthly figure for that (clothing, groceries)?
3. Please break down the tax figure for me. What portion of the \$260,000 =igure is 2016 taxes paid in 2017, what portion is 2017 taxes and what =ortion is estimated payments towards 2018 taxes. Please also tell =e how the figure reconciles with the tax payments (\$180K) in all that we made on Noam's behalf in December of =017.
4. The schedule is styled "NOAM & VALERIA CHOMSKY INCOME =TATEMENT" but there is no information on income. Can you =lease advise what their income was (and what the sources =ere).
5. I understood that you were finding a source of funds for Noam to pay his =axes on time. Was that the case, or is interest =ccruing?
6. On the line marked [REDACTED] "plus" all =he additional information that you can offer to me, or will there be =ore?
7. Were there any gifts made by Noam to anyone, including Valeria? (I =now this is a delicate question. If Noam could say something like =E2◆◆the aggregate of all gifts, including any to Valeria, did not =xceed \$10,000" that would be fine.)
