Hi Jeffrey,

Attached is a chart comparing some of the split-dollar proposals that we discussed with McDermott. We thought you might like to have this before tomorrow's meeting.

Proposal One is the same proposal we suggested to you at our November 6th meeting. We asked Marilyn to comment on it right after the meeting but McDermott only just approved of it on a call today (they actually presented it as if it were their own proposal!). Proposal Two is yet another new plan that Marilyn suggested on our call today. Also illustrated is a plan she proposed on November 18, 2013 and one she proposed on December 5, 2011.

The attached chart is intended to be accompanied by a memorandum I am still preparing for Leon which gives more color to the history of the split-dollar agreements and the various discussions and proposals since 2010.
