I'm writing at the suggestion of Julie Taymor. Julie is the Honorary Co-Chair of Theatre for a New Audience's capital campaign for the first theatre for Shakespeare and classic drama to be built in New York City since Lincoln Center's 1965 Vivian Beaumont. I understand Julie spoke with you at the recent W=V Conference and you invited us to contact you. Thank you. I would very much appreciate speaking.

As you will read, this is a \$68.5 million campaign. We have raised \$52.7 million to date and are in the final stretch to raise the remaining \$16 million.
