We met with someone from Rafanelli Events today who planned Chelsea Clinton's wedding. I found them online and called to ask about how they handle confidentiality agreements, dealing with vendors, etc.. Their business development director was in NY today working on other projects so we met with him to get a sense for who they are. They just did a wedding in Jackson Hole last August so have someone on their team familiar with Jackson and vendors, etc.. They would manage all vendors and their staff as far as confidentiality, making sure no one takes photos, etc.. They usually have all staff check in their cell phones and have even confiscated an employee's cell phone in the past. They would be a one stop shop to take care of everything from rehearsal dinner, ceremony, reception, caterers, flowers, entertainment, photography, stationary, wedding website, organizing accommodations, transportation to and from wedding site, etc, etc.. Most importantly they would know how to properly handle confidentiality and discretion with everyone involved. Where as the woman in Jackson says she can't be responsible for vendors and their staff as she is a one woman show, thus I would need to be the one to enforce all the vendors to sign an agreement...) They are not cheap though. Their minimum fee is \$25,000. Did you have a budget in mind for what I can spend on the wedding so I know whether it's feasible or not to use them? Attached are their confidentiality agreements and service agreements. What do you think?
