Paxos, Greece €5m

It's not quite Skopelos, the Greek island owned by the shipping billionaires Aristotle Onassis that his granddaughter sold last month for a reported £100m, but the 10-hectare Katsiklos, which lies off the southwestern tip of Paxos, is up for sale. The new owners will be able to build their own 300 sq metre villa on the densely wooded, pebbly island, which has a small, 17th-century church and can be reached via a coastal road or by boat from Gaios. The rest of the island is protected forest, but the owners will have it all to themselves.

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
