> This is a nice little box. It uses the Oculus optics and some of the =PIs developed by them. Field of view is about 90-110 degrees but the =esolution is very nice. It is tied to the one Samsung device (a very =ice phone). The first units that will be coming out are developer =nits, though they should be available to anyone that wants to purchase =t.

> Of course our field of view is much larger and we will work with any 7 =r 8 inch tablet for the first device. We are beginning to look at what =t would take to support phones as well - a higher power lens will give =s the same field of view we have now but work with a 5 inch phone.
