Per our conversation, I have attached a one-page summary and recent deck for inStream, the first comprehensive practice management software platform for independent financial advisors (RIAs). In 2013, inStream raised circa \$5M from a great investor group, and is now raising a convertible note, bridging into the upcoming Series B round.
