basically viruses are entering the body through the vagus (or whatever else has receptors in the upper airway)  
just as I had predicted

i've always thought this could be done through a throat or nose (aerosolized) spray and would only involve an  
external adherent to the receptors where they are entering

its just a stick barrier - like a structural but microscopic mucus since the upper aiways doesn't make it
