

Election 2014: New Mexico Governor

New Mexico Governor: Martinez (R) 50%, King (D) 37%

Friday, September 26, 2014

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Incumbent Republican Susana Martinez is back on track to be reelected governor of New Mexico.

New Mexico moves from a Toss-Up to Safe Republican on the Rasmussen Reports 2014 Gubernatorial Scorecard. Martinez, a former district attorney, was first elected governor in 2010 with 53% of the vote. (To see survey question wording, [click here](#).)

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The survey of 830 Likely Voters in New Mexico was conducted on September 22-23, 2014 by Rasmussen Reports. The margin of sampling error is +/- 4 percentage points with a 95% level of confidence. Field work for all Rasmussen Reports surveys is conducted by Pulse Opinion Research, LLC.
