Black

- DW did ChatGPT search related to Leon Black settlement; dealings with Brad Edwards
  - o Results: Black retained Edwards as part of a legal settlement of allegations filed against him; 2022 Jane Doe settlement
    - Edwards was involved in negotiating a settlement [DW thinks this could have been the Jane Doe case that settled]
    - *There have been other instances where a victim's attorney has been hired by the defendant; happened in the Bill O'Reilly case*
  - o DW asked for the sources for that answer: cases involving Jeffrey Epstein, some confidential
  - o In follow up questions, ChatGPT responded there was no reliable source information linking Edwards as counsel for Black [[nb: sounds like this was mistake by ChatGPT; does not seem relevant]]
- Conference coming up in Wigdor's case
